Those celebrating birthdays, anniversaries, or whom God is sending out to new ministries are invited to come forward during the Doxology, offering themselves in rededication to the Lord.



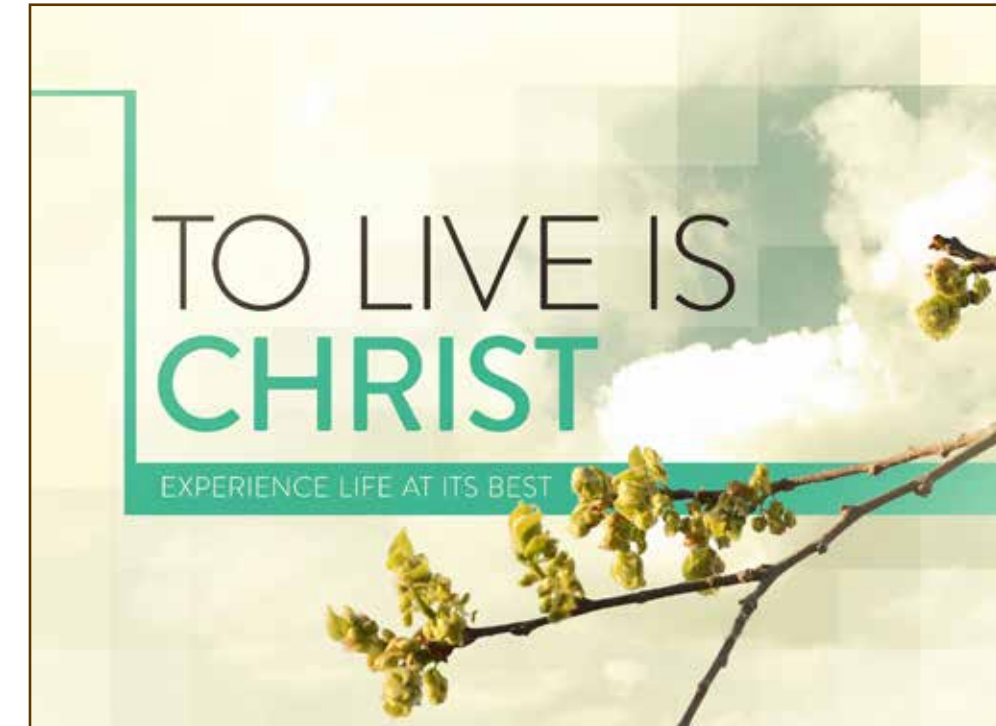
