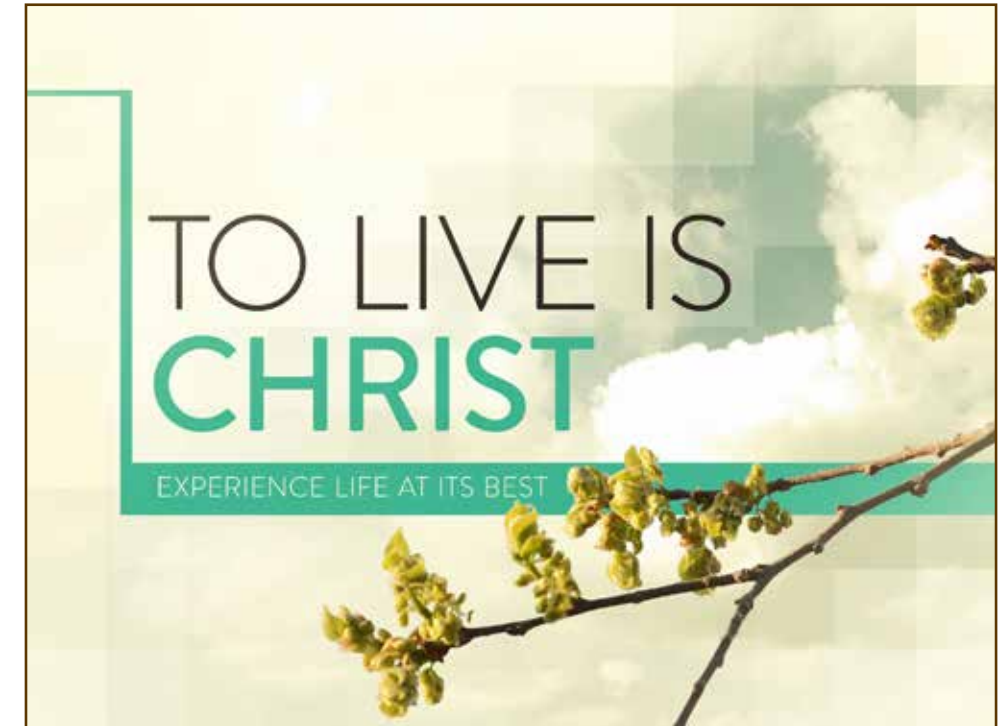

They recently sent a list of praises and prayer requests: *"Praises* - •We have had a rain-filled January in Mzuzu, which is good for the many rural subsistence farmers who primarily grow corn. •A new term for residential students at the University of Livingstonia has begun. Tyler is teaching 4 courses to the residential and distance learning students as well as continuing with several campus library and IT projects. *Prayer requests* - •Rochelle will be in the field doing a water stewardship training with rice farmers for 4 days in Karonga, one of the hardest hit areas of Malawi by cholera. She will be taking every precaution for her health and for the University team with her. Also, please surround her trip with your prayers. It is a balance, as despite cholera outbreaks, other important work cannot come to a standstill. •We are looking at schooling options for Mphatso next year as her current preschool does not offer the next level and we are considering several elementary school options for September. Please pray for discernment for us as we visit area schools."
