Whether you're a wild 'n' rugged tent camper, tow a trailer, or prefer the air-conditioned life in the lodge, everyone is invited to come to Ingalls Creek this summer. Ingalls Creek Enrichment Center is located in Peshastin, WA (near Leavenworth), in the heart of the Cascade Mountains.

Spend time with old friends, and make some new ones. Come worship, play, relax and declare the glory of God in the natural beauty of His creation. Can't come for the whole weekend? No problem, come for as long as you can!

## Activities

- Worship, movies, and making s'mores and wop wops in the outdoor amphitheater. (What's a wop wop? We're not telling, you'll have to come and find out!)

# The Amenities

## RV & Tent Camping Sites (Thursday-Sunday)

The camp sites are rustic, with no hookups available (limited power available upon request), so be ready to be off the grid. Bring all your usual camping equipment. Flush toilets, potable water, and hot showers are available throughout the campground and in the lodge.

\$60 per site (up to 5 people).  
Thursday is an additional \$30/site.

## Stay in the Lodge (Friday-Sunday Only)

Looking for more civilized accommodation? The lodge has two dormitory style rooms with bunk beds and bathrooms. There are also two family suites available. Lodge guests may use the kitchen for cooking and food storage. Bring your own bedding (pillow and sleeping bag or sheet and blanket).

\$125 Lupine Suite  
\$150 Alpine Suite  
(max. 4 people per suite)

### Friday, June 29


- Lodge guests arrive
