Middle School (gr. 6-8): Basic


WS South Room 306/Basement (youth rooms)

The New Life Course provides three years of foundational instruction to help us live into our life with Jesus. It is especially geared for people who have already gone through Alpha and are in an A2 (After-Alpha) Life Group. But it is open to anyone who would like to go deeper into the foundations of our faith as well as any Life Group that would like to opt into this material.

For the winter of 2019, we are going to be look at ten essential qualities of our God. There is a basic biblical principle that teaches us that we become like that which we worship. God reveals Himself so that we might know him, worship Him, and even enjoy Him. To commit ourselves to knowing Him as He reveals himself. To give up our own ideas and seek to overturn misunderstanding and misconceptions is to step into our salvation. As we come to know the one true God, in all of his beauty and goodness, we will be changed and our passion to trust and follow Jesus will only increase.

We will have about 40 minutes of large group teaching and discussion. Then A2 Life Groups and Life Groups will have the chance to meet, pray and grow together. We will also form discussion groups for people who are not yet in a Life Group. It is my conviction that the process of actively discussing and wrestling through the material will increase our learning.

I think there is no greater or inspiring opportunity than to commit ourselves to grow deeper in knowing the one true God.
