Basic is a high-energy time for middle school students to enjoy fellowship and explore Jesus. Students will be dismissed at 5:50 pm from the meal.

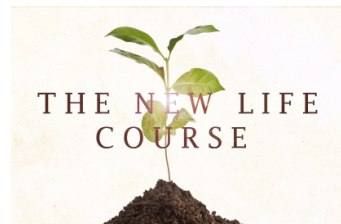

Following Jesus is all about relationships, but the most important relationship is our relationship with God. When we choose to follow Jesus as Lord and Savior, the Spirit of God enters our hearts. We now live in the Spirit. It means new outlook, new power, and new purpose. In this seminar, we are not only going to discover more about the Holy Spirit, but we are going to begin the process of discerning the gifts and calling that the Spirit wants to work in our lives.

We will have about 40 minutes of large group teaching and discussion. Then Life Groups (including A2) will have the chance to meet, pray and grow together.
